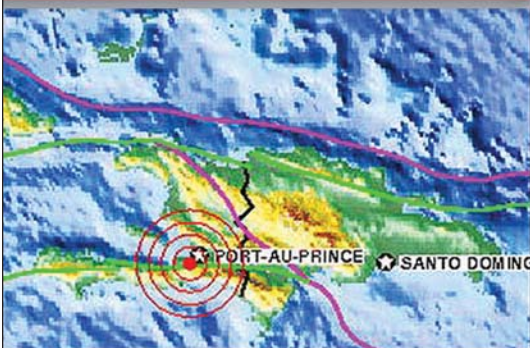
Haiti Response Fund
